Pam, are you the right person for this?

I need a draft to accomplish Commerce's request that is copied below:

Delete the Certified Capital Companies fee appropriation [s. 20.143 (1) (hm)] and the WDF loan origination fee appropriation [s. 20.143 (1) (gm)] and transfer the balances and position authority to the Economic Development Operations fee appropriation [s. 20.143 (1) (h)]. The consolidated fee appropriation would fund a grants specialist position in the Bureau of Business Finance, a state auditor position, currently vacant, in the Office of Loan and Grant Administration, and two CAPCO positions that were authorized by the legislature in 1997 Act 215 - a financial examiner and a financial specialist.

(Dawn: this is for Commerce. Let's call it "economic development fees consolidation".)

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Under current law, an appropriation to the department of commerce (department) consists of origination fees that are used for the costs of administering a number of the department's grant and loan programs and for underwriting the costs of the grants and loans. Another appropriation to the department consists of fees received by the department from certified capital companies that are used for the cost of administering the department's capital company certification program. A third appropriation to the department consists of amounts reimbursed to the department by WHEDA for the department's costs in promoting economic development programs financed by WHEDA through issuing bonds. The bill combines the first two appropriations into the third appropriation, retaining all sources of funding and all purposes, and transfers any unencumbered balances in the accounts of the first two appropriations to the account of the third appropriation.
