**Subject:** Department of Transportation Statutory Language

I am forwarding statutory language changes that we would like to have drafted for inclusion in the Department of Transportation's budget.

1. Increase the registration fee for motor vehicles from \$45 to \$55. Effective January 1, 2002.
2. Provide that the Department of Transportation may not use transportation revenue bonds to fund more than 53 percent of the Major Highways Program. Make this change effective July 1, 2002 (fiscal year 2003).
3. Create an appropriation to fund the reconstruction of the Marquette Interchange in Milwaukee.
- \* [ 4. Require the Department of Transportation to change the name of the Transportation Economic Assistance (TEA) program to the "Tommy G. Thompson Transportation Economic Assistance" program.

## Analysis

Head TRANSPORTATION

Sub TRANSPORTATION AIDS

Under current law, DOT administers a transportation facilities economic assistance and development program.

Under the program, DOT may improve a highway, airport, or harbor, or provide other assistance for the improvement of those transportation facilities or certain rail property or railroad tracks, as part of a major economic development project. DOT may also make loans for the improvement of any of these transportation facilities. The state share of costs for the improvement of any transportation facility may not exceed 50% of the cost of the improvement.

This bill renames the program the "Tommy G. Thompson transportation facilities economic assistance and development program".
