**Subject:** Recycling Statutory Language

I'm forwarding statutory language requests based on Governor's recommendations:

1. Provide \$7.0 million <sup>each year</sup> from the Shared Revenue Program to establish two recycling challenge grant programs
2. The two challenge grant programs will be administered by the Department of Commerce.
3. Earmark \$5.0 million each year to provide one-time grants to encourage local governments to establish regional recycling programs.
4. Require DNR to develop a proposal, for inclusion in the 2003-2005 biennial budget, to revise the municipal recycling grant formula to allow consideration of regional recycling grants.
5. Earmark \$2.0 million each year to provide grants to local governments to implement innovative organic materials management strategies. Grants should be competitive based on thoroughness, effectiveness, and viability of the strategy.
6. Require the Recycling Market Development Board to work with municipalities to develop viable markets for the reuse of their organic materials.
7. Provide Commerce with the authority to make rules to implement both challenge grant programs.

Under current law, DNR administers a financial assistance program to assist local governmental units that are responsible for recycling programs (called responsible units) with costs related to operating those programs. Ordinarily, a city, village, or town is the responsible unit for the city, village, or town. However, counties may choose to become responsible units. Also, a city, village, town, or county may enter into a contract with any other governmental unit for that other governmental unit to be the responsible unit for the city, village, town, or county. Generally the amount of financial assistance that a responsible unit receives is based on the amount of financial assistance that the responsible unit received, or would have received, for 1999.

This bill requires DNR to submit to DOA a proposal for changing the method for determining the amount of financial assistance provided for recycling programs to encourage regional recycling programs.
