

The following is a statutory language proposal for the 2001-03 biennial budget. If you have any questions, please contact me at 266-7973 or [kirsten.grinde@doa.state.wi.us](mailto:kirsten.grinde@doa.state.wi.us).

The intent of this request is to increase the annual vehicle admission fees for state parks and other "vehicle admission areas." The current resident annual fee would increase from \$17.50 to \$19.50. The current nonresident annual fee would increase from \$24.50 to \$26.50. The reduced fees under s. 27.01(7)(gm)1. would increase from \$8.50 to \$9.50 and \$12 to \$13, respectively. The fees for senior citizens would not change.
