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

I am forwarding statutory language change that we would like to have drafted for inclusion in the Department of Natural Resource's (DNR) budget.

1999 Wisconsin Act 9 created s. 285.69 (2)(a) 8. This section requires DNR to use a 5-year rolling average from the proceeding 5-years to determine the emissions fee for a stationary source. The intent of this request is to change the 5-year rolling average to a year-to-year average.

Under current law, the owner or operator of a stationary source of air pollution who must obtain an air pollution control permit from DNR is required to pay an annual fee to DNR. The amount of the fee is determined under rules promulgated by DNR that must comply with a number of requirements, including that the fee billed for each stationary source in each year after 2001 be based on actual emissions of pollutants from the source in the preceding five years, using a five-year rolling average. Under this bill, the fee ~~the fee~~ billed for each stationary source in each year after 2001 must be based on actual emissions of pollutants from the source in the preceding year, rather than the preceding five years.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

2 SECTION 1. 285.69 (2) (a) 8. of the statutes is amended to read:  
3 285.69 (2) (a) 8. That the fee billed for each stationary source in each year after  
4 2001 is based on the actual emissions of all regulated pollutants, and any other air

1 contaminant specified by the department in the rules, in the preceding 5 years, using  
2 a ~~5~~-year rolling average year.
