

I'm forwarding statutory language requests based on Governor's recommendations:

- ✓ 1. Provide the Department of Commerce with same enforcement authority as the Department of Natural Resources under the spills law
- ✓ 2. Provide the Department of Commerce with administrative and enforcement authority equal to those provided to the Department of Natural Resources under s. 292.15
- ✓ 3. Provide the Department of Natural Resources with jurisdictional authority and oversight over all voluntary party brownfield sites related to the Dry Cleaner Environmental Response Program, DNR's share of PECFA and LUST sites, and all landfills.
- ✓ 4. Commerce will have jurisdictional authority and oversight over all other brownfield sites participating in the voluntary party process.
- ✓ 5. Rather than requiring DNR to report on the impact of liability exemptions biennially under s. 292.25, require both DNR and Commerce incorporate a detailed discussion of the voluntary party process and liability exemptions in their report/evaluation of brownfield efforts under s.292.255. The detailed discussion should include all information currently required by statute under s. 292.25.
- ✓ 6. Provide the Department of Commerce with authority to carry out provisions under s.292.55
- ✓ 7. Transfer the Brownfields Site Assessment Grant program to the Department of Commerce. Eliminate appropriation s. 20.370 (6)(ct). Funding to continue the grant program will be appropriated out of s. 20.143 (1)(qm)
- ✓ 8. Earmark \$2.0 million of the amount appropriated under s. 20.143(1)(qm) in the first year of the biennium for site assessment grants. Provide Commerce with the authority to write rules to implement the site assessment grant program.

Manyee,

When you say that this is entirely separate, do you mean that the funding source is entirely separate (which I understand) or that the program is entirely separate? If the latter, I really don't understand because the program under s. 560.139 (1) provides money to the City of Milwaukee for a program to be administered by the Milwaukee Economic Development Corporation to provide grants for remediation and economic development in the Menomonee Valley. That sounds like what this money is supposed to be used for. The brownfields request states that the money is to continue the Corporation's matching grant program. If that program is not the same one that is referenced in s. 560.139 (1), I think that I will need more information about what the current matching grant program is..

Hmm...It is very similar to the program in s. 560.139(1) but it's really something entirely separate. My understanding is that the gaming revenue (\$2.5 million in each year of the biennium) will be deposited into the environmental fund. The money will then be appropriated to appropriation s. 20.143 (1)(qm). \$2.0 million per year will be earmarked for brownfields redevelopment in the Menomonee Valley.

I asked John Koskinen (team leader on the tax team) whether appropriate language has been provided for the gaming revenue transfer to the environment fund. He is looking into it and will send in something to the LRB if it is missing. Perhaps you could also check with the appropriate drafter over at LRB on this?
