Under current law, DHFS receives moneys as fees for inspecting, licensing, approving, and performing various other duties with respect to facilities such as nursing homes, community-based residential facilities, hospitals, and hospices. The moneys are required to be expended for the costs of performing these services.

This bill lapses to the general fund on June 30, 2002, \$1,000,000 of the revenues received as fees for facility inspection, approval, and other services, and lapses to the general fund on June 30, 2003, an additional \$200,000 of the revenues.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
