The following is a statutory language proposal for the 2001-03 biennial budget. If you have any questions, please contact me at 266-7973 or kirsten.grinde@doa.state.wi.us.

The intent of this request is to create a new PR-S appropriation within the Department of Natural Resources to receive funding from the main tribal gaming revenue appropriation in the Department of Administration [s. 20.505 (8) (hm)]. The new appropriation in the Department of Natural Resources would allow expenditure of the funds for law enforcement aids to counties as authorized under s. 350.12 (4) (a) 4. to be used exclusively for the enforcement of ch. 350. These funds would be in addition to the aids provided from the appropriation under s. 20.370 (5) (es).


