Court Reporter Transcript Fees

Motion:

Move to increase transcript fees from parties requesting a transcript (excluding the state or any political subdivision) from \$1.75 per 25-line page for the original and 60¢ per 25-line page for each copy to \$2.25 and 50¢ respectively. Further, provide that for expedited transcripts, an additional fee of 75¢ per 25-line page for the original and 25¢ per 25-line page for each copy shall be charged to the party requesting the transcript. Define "expedited transcripts" as those transcripts that are requested by a party to be prepared within 7 days but are not required to be prepared within 7 days by rule or by statute.

**Court Reporter Transcript Fees**

Section 814.69 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

**814.69 Fees of court reporters; transcripts. (1) A court reporter shall collect the following fees:**

(b) for a transcript under s. 757.57 (5), a fee from the party requesting the transcript at the rate of ~~\$1.75~~ \$2.25 per 25-line page for the original and ~~60~~ 50 cents per 25-line page for each copy. If the request is by the state or any political subdivision thereof, the fees of the reporter shall be at the rates provided in par. (a).

Section 814.69 (1) (bm) of the statutes is created to read:

**814.69 (1) (bm)** For expedited transcripts, an additional fee of 75 cents per 25-line page for the original and 25 cents per 25-line page for each copy shall be charged to the party requesting the transcript. Expedited transcripts are those transcripts that are requested by a party to be prepared within 7 days but are not required to be prepared within 7 days by rule or by statute.
