- B) Delete the third paragraph entirely.
- C) Add the Following: "Require the Department of Transportation to provide \$410,000 (which is the interest accumulated by delaying the payment to the stadium district until Jan 2003) to Brown County, the City of Green Bay and the Village of Ashwaubenon for use in paying for costs associated with the CTH "VK"/Lombardi Avenue project. All funds will be divided in direct proportion to the costs borne by each government."

7. Grants to Local Professional Football Stadium Districts (Paper #906, Alt. A3 plus changes) -Modify the Governor's recommendation by specifying that the grants to a local professional football stadium district could only be used for the development, construction, reconstruction or improvement of parking lots, garages, transportation facilities or other functionally-related or auxiliary facilities or structures, on the existing parking lot facility of a professional-football-stadium.

Require that the Department of Transportation provide the \$9.1 million grant to the local professional football stadium district in January, 2003.

Require the local professional football stadium district to provide the entire \$9.1 million in grant proceeds to a professional football team to be used for the purposes specified within 30 days of receiving the grant funds. Increase estimated transportation fund revenue by \$205,000 in 2001-02 to reflect additional investment earnings due to the delayed payment.

8. Mass Transit Operating Assistance -- Funding Level (Paper #907) -- Modify the Governor's recommendation by providing annual mass transit aid increases (SEG) for 2002 and 2003 at 4% and 2%, respectively. Set the distributions for each tier and change the mass transit aid appropriations as shown below:

D. PROJECT DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION:

The proposed street improvement project consists of the 2002 reconstruction of the 1.0-mile segment of Lombardi, Ridge Road to Ashland Avenue. The existing 4-lane undivided rural asphalt roadway will be converted to a 4-lane divided concrete urban boulevard with curb & gutter, center landscaped median, storm sewer, and sidewalks

The project will begin at the east side of the intersection of Ridge Road and continue to Ashland Avenue, with two (2) 12-foot travel lanes in each direction separated by an 18-foot wide grass center median. In the segment bordering the Lambeau Field parking lot, Ridge Road to Oneida Street, a third lane will be added for eastbound traffic to access and leave Lambeau Field from two (2) new entrances off of Lombardi Avenue. Pedestrian movement and safety will be improved with wide center medians for refuge and sidewalks. Intersection capacity and safety improvements will be made at the intersections of Oneida Street, Holmgren Way, and Forward Street.

This proposed construction project is the first segment of a 2-phase project to reconstruct and improve Lombardi Avenue from USH 41 to Ashland Avenue. The 1.0-mile segment of Lombardi Avenue, from Ridge Road to USH 41 will be reconstructed and upgraded to a 6-lane divided boulevard in 2003, with improvements to the intersections of Ridge Road and Marlee Lane/Military Avenue.

The reconstruction work on Lombardi Avenue is being closely planned and coordinated with the Lambeau Field renovation work, which will be completed by the Fall of 2003.

The engineering design for the Phase 1 - 2002 Lombardi Avenue construction project is being carried out by Graef, Anhalt, Schloemer & Associates. In the Spring of 2002, the Brown County Highway Department will "let" contractor bids for the proposed concrete street construction work. Construction will be carried out from May to September 2002.


