This joint project among Departments of Transportation, Natural Resources and local snowmobile groups has been in the works for a couple years. Proposed is a 14-foot wide bridge over I-90 that would accommodate bicyclists, snowmobilers and hikers. It would provide a more convenient and safer connection for bicyclists between the Elroy-Sparta state trail and the La Crosse River state trail. It would provide a more convenient and safer connection for snowmobilers between trails north and south of I-90.

Total cost of this project is \$620,000. Using federal "enhancement," funds, Wisconsin Department of Transportation is providing 80% of the cost, or \$496,000.

The local share of this project is 20%, or \$124,000. The local sponsors are area snowmobile organizations. This amendment provides local share of \$124,000 from program revenue (DNR snowmobile account).
