Dear Senator Hansen:

The City of Marinette has two grant applications pending with the Waterways Commission. The Stephenson Island and Boom Landing applications request funding for boat launch parking lot improvements. Additionally, the Boom Landing project requests funding to improve the launching facilities.

The improvements at both sites are essential due the low water conditions present on the Menominee River. Of the four boat landings the City maintains, two are virtually unusable under the current conditions. Therefore, adequate parking must be provided at the two remaining landings boaters have come to rely upon.

Stephenson Island Parking Lot

Total Project Cost-\$160,537.00
City Share-\$109,764.00
State Grant Share-\$50,773.00

The project will relocate and expand the parking facilities on Stephenson Island to an area adjacent to U.S. Hwy 41.

Boom Landing Parking Lot

Total Project Cost-\$383,502.04
City Share-\$191,751.02

The project will double the current parking area at the most popular boat landing in the City. The project also includes the expansion of the boat launch well, changing the grade of the existing launch ramp, and dredging of the river adjacent to the ramp. The timing of this project is critical, since the Marinette Marine dredging project will be underway, and the City could realize substantial savings if it is able to use the same contractor Marinette Marine employs.

I am asking that you consider including these two projects in the State budget so that the City can maintain the facilities for sport fishing in the community. As you are aware, sport fishing is important to the City's tourism economy, and adequate facilities are necessary to meet the needs of those who come here for that purpose.
