

1 department of health and family services shall in state fiscal year 2001-02 distribute  
 2 moneys to applying providers of services under home and community-based waiver  
 3 programs under 42 USC 1396n (c), including the long-term support community  
 4 options program under section 46.27 of the statutes and the community integration  
 5 programs under sections 46.275, 46.277, and 46.278 of the statutes, to offset costs of  
 6 providing health insurance to employees of the providers. Moneys distributed under  
 7 this subsection to an applying provider are limited to the amount the provider  
 8 expends for employee health care insurance costs or \$50,000, whichever is less.”
