1 AN ACT to amend 341.09 (8); and to create 341.13 (2m) of the statutes, relating
2 to: registration plates for motorcycles.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires all vehicle registration plates, including motorcycle registration plates, to display the name "Wisconsin" or its abbreviation, the vehicle's registration number, and the expiration date of registration or the date on which the vehicle was registered. Current law does not dictate the size or, with limited exceptions, the color of registration plates.

This bill requires registration plates for motorcycles to have black lettering on a white background and to be 4 inches by 7 inches in size.
