1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	1. Page 582, line 8: after that line insert:
3	"SECTION 1633m. 48.62 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	48.62 (4) Monthly payments in foster care shall be provided according to the
5	age–related rates specified in this subsection. Beginning on January 1, 2000, the
6	age–related rates are: \$299 for children aged 4 and under; \$326 for children aged 5
7	to 11; \$371 for children aged 12 to 14 and \$387 for children aged 15 to 17. Beginning
8	on January 1, 2001, the age–related rates are: \$302 for children aged 4 and under;
9	\$329 for children aged 5 to 11; \$375 for children aged 12 to 14; and \$391 for children
10	aged 15 to 17. <u>Beginning on January 1, 2002, the age-related rates are: \$402 for</u>
11	<u>children aged 4 and under; \$429 for children aged 5 to 11; \$475 for children aged 12</u>
12	to 14; and \$491 for children aged 15 to 17. In addition to these grants for basic

maintenance, the department shall make supplemental payments for special needs,
exceptional circumstances, care in a treatment foster home, and initial clothing
allowances according to rules promulgated by the department.".
