PR	\$2,460,100	28.00

Provide \$412,600 in 2001-02 and \$2,047,500 in 2002-03 to fund 28.0 positions, beginning in 2001-02, to staff a new community-based residential facility (CBRF) that will be built as part of the Southern Wisconsin Veterans Retirement Center (SWVRC). Modify the Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA) institutional operations appropriation to authorize DVA to expend funds from the appropriation to support the SWVRC.

1999 Act 9 provided \$23,100,300 in bonding authority to construct several facilities at the SWVRC, including a new 48-bed CBRF. DVA estimates that the facility will be completed in October, 2001.

WISCONSIN HEALTH AND EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES AUTHORITY

1. DEFINITION OF AN EDUCATIONAL FACILITY

Modify the definition of an "educational facility," as it relates to projects for which WHEFA may issue bonds, to delete the requirement that the facility be a post-secondary educational institution. Current law defines an "educational facility" as a regionally accredited, private, postsecondary educational institution that is considered tax exempt under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Under this provision, facilities used for primary and second education would be eligible for WHEFA financing.

WHEFA is a quasi-public organization authorized to issue bonds to finance capital projects for health care institutions, independent colleges and universities and child care facilities.

2 1. Page 237, line 16: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2001-02 by
3 \$412,600 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2002-03 by \$2,047,500 to
4 increase funding for the operation of the Southern Wisconsin Veterans Retirement
5 Center.

6 2. Page 381, line 21: after that line insert:

7 "SECTION 783p. 20.485 (1) (gk)^x of the statutes is amended to read:

8 20.485 (1) (gk) *Institutional operations*. The amounts in the schedule for the
9 care of the Wisconsin Veterans Home at King, the Southern Wisconsin Veterans

1 Retirement Center, and veterans facilities. All moneys received under par. (m) and
2 s. 45.37 (9) (d) and (9d) shall be credited to this appropriation.”.

3 **3.** Page 1368, line 4: after that line insert:

4 “(8b) SOUTHERN WISCONSIN VETERANS RETIREMENT CENTER. The authorized FTE
5 positions for the department of veterans affairs are increased by 28.0 PR positions,
6 to be funded from the appropriation under section 20.485 (1) (gk) of the statutes, as
7 affected by this act, for the operation of the Southern Wisconsin Veterans Retirement
8 Center.”.
