I would like to propose two additional amendments to the state budget for our caucus to consider. Along with my request I have included a brief description of the provision and its budget history.

## **Provide \$250,000 for Chippewa Valley Technical College health education center**

The first amendment is a provision included in the Senate Budget, providing up to \$250,000 in 2001-02 and 2002-03 to the Chippewa Valley Technical College for a health education center. The Senate proposes financing the project with gaming economic development grants. Gov. McCallum proposed \$500,000 in each year of the biennium, but the funding was removed by JFC. Rep. Kreibich's amendment to restore the governor's recommendation failed in caucus.

When the technical college hosted JFC in March the health education center was their top priority.

Language from Senate Amendment 2, to Senate Substitute Amendment 1, to SB55.

Grants to Chippewa Valley Technical College. From the appropriation under section 20.143 (1) (kj) of the statutes, as affected by this act, the department of commerce may make grants of up to \$250,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 and up to \$250,000 in fiscal year 2002-03 to the Chippewa Valley Technical College for a health care education center. If the department of commerce makes a grant under this subsection, the department of commerce shall enter into an agreement with the Chippewa Valley Technical College that specifies the uses for the grant proceeds and reporting and auditing requirements.

## **Increase funding for the Wisconsin Partnership Program (WPP) and Program for All Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) to levels recommended by the Governor - 13% in 2001-02 and 22.8% 2002-03**

The second amendment I ask the caucus to consider was brought to my attention this week by a few dozen constituents concerned about WPP/PACE. These programs serve the same populations as COP and CIP but serve only Eau Claire, Dane, Milwaukee, Chippewa, Clark, and Dunn counties.

JFC reduced the Governor's recommendation for increased WPP/PACE funding from 13% in 2001-02 and 22.8% in 2002-03 down to 8% in each year. JFC members argue that these programs serve only a limited area and that it may be more appropriate to reduce this funding, and instead use the funding for additional COP slots or MA waiver programs that serve the whole state.

Increasing WPP/PACE funding to the governor's recommendation will increase GPR costs by \$986,500 in 2001-02 and \$4,406,100 in 2002-03. I have enclosed the Fiscal Bureau summary as it relates to WPP/PACE in the Senate budget amendment. Unfortunately, I could not find the specific language for this amendment in Folio.
