The current state recycling tipping fee of \$0.30 per ton has done nothing to slow the influx of out-of-state waste into Wisconsin landfills. In addition, the extremely low fee charged to waste haulers has created a deficit in the state's recycling program. If Governor McCallum and Republican Lawmakers have their way, recycling grants will be cut by 40%, from \$24.5 million this year to \$14 million in 2002, and \$13.5 million in 2003.

The DNR and numerous organizations representing local government have proposed an increase in the state recycling tipping fee of \$1.55 per ton, maintaining state recycling grants at \$24.5 million through 2004. Senator Decker introduced a motion in Finance to increase tipping fees by \$10 per ton, however, the motion failed 8-8.

**3) Designate Lake Wissota Business Park as a Technology Development Zone**  
Department of Commerce – Departmentwide and Economic Development  
No issue Paper – Item #22

Last week JFC approved the creation of 9 Technology Development Zones for the promotion of high tech business in Wisconsin. The first three will be sited by the Department of Commerce. The final six will also be sited by Commerce pending approval by JFC.

I would like to offer a budget amendment designating one of these zones in Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin at the Lake Wissota Business Park.

A number of factors about the Chippewa Valley make it an ideal location for a technology development zone to foster high-tech industry in Wisconsin.

- a) This region has a labor force of over 84,000 skilled workers, unique to northern WI.
- b) The Chippewa Valley is part of the nation's top rated technical college system (CVTC) and top ranked public university system (UWEC).
- c) The location for a proposed technology zone includes over 200 acres of fully developed industrial property.
- d) The businesses that would benefit from this tax break include both established and fledgling high-tech firms.
