Summary

This amendment would, effective July 1, 2003, provide a fuel tax exemption for school districts. In addition, local municipalities and counties would be granted an exemption, effective July 1, 2004.

Fiscal Impact

None this biennium.

Once enacted, the DOR estimates the school district fuel tax exemption to decrease revenues by \$1.9 million annually. Additionally, the DOR estimates the local municipalities and counties exemption to decrease revenues by \$13 million annually. The Department also anticipates expenses of \$5,000 to provide the exemption.
