## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill would affect DHFS's Health Insurance Risk Sharing Plan (HIRSP) program. Funding for the HIRSP program is provided by state GPR, policyholder premiums, assessments to the insurance industry, and assessments to health-care providers in the form of provider discounts. Because the level of state GPR support for the program is fixed, policyholders, the insurance industry and health-care providers support any additional cost to the program in a 60/20/20 split, respectively.

This bill modifies the HIRSP program's prescription drug coverage. It requires the Department to establish for prescription drug coverage: copayments, coinsurance rates and copayment and coinsurance out-of-pocket limits over which HIRSP pays 100% of covered prescription drug costs. Any established copayment amount, coinsurance rate, or out-of-pocket limits are subject to the approval of the HIRSP Board of Directors. Currently, it is unknown what copayment amount, coinsurance rate, or out-of-pocket limits will be approved by the HIRSP Board. A fiscal estimate is not possible at this time.
