Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Assumptions used in arriving at Fiscal Estimate: SB173 would direct the Wisconsin Higher Educational Aids Board (HEAB) to establish and administer a child care worker loan repayment program. The program would allow child care workers to be reimbursed for ten percent of the outstanding principal amount on their educational loans up to \$1,000 if certain criteria are met. It is assumed that up to 500 students could participate each year taking a minimum of \$1,000 in loans over a two year period. Each of the 500 students could receive \$100 in loan repayment. Administering a program as described that includes 500 participants requires a .5 specialist which would allow two hours per year for each participant.

In order to establish and administer this program, a half time Grant Specialist (program coordinator) and a quarter time Comprehensive Professional (computer systems specialist) would need to be funded.
