
Affected Chapter 20 Appropriations

Assumptions Used In Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law classifies police officers, fire fighters and other individuals whose jobs involve a high degree of danger and physical conditioning as protective occupation participants. This bill classifies teachers and librarians employed at state correctional facilities, secured correctional facilities, the mental health institutes, the Wisconsin Resource Center and a secure mental health unit or facility for sexually violent persons as protective occupation participants for the purpose of the Wisconsin Retirement System.

The salary of teachers and librarians employed by the Department who work at any of the institutions listed above is \$2,266,083 GPR annually and \$356,209 PR annually. Under current law, the amount of fringe generated by those positions is \$802,200 GPR and \$126,100 PR annually. Under this bill, fringe costs will increase to \$985,100 GPR and \$154,800 PR annually. The cost to the state for the provisions of this bill that affect institutions administered by the Department will be \$182,900 GPR and \$28,700 PR annually.
