Subject Automatic sprinkler systems on college campuses		

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB 480 contains several provisions requiring the installation of fire sprinkler systems in residence halls and dormitories that are owned or operated by institutions of higher learning other than the University of Wisconsin System or a fraternity, sorority, or other organization authorized or sponsored by an institution of higher education.

SB 480 requires the Department to update its rules to incorporate the provisions of the bill requiring fire sprinkler systems in the indicated buildings.

The Department updates the applicable rules (Comm 50-64, Commercial Building Code; Comm 66, Multifamily Dwelling Code; Comm 20-25, Uniform Dwelling Code; Comm 75-79, Existing Buildings; Comm 14, Fire Prevention) regularly and any necessary updates resulting from this legislation would be done as part of that process. This would result in no additional workload for the Department. Therefore, the bill would have no fiscal impact on the Department.
