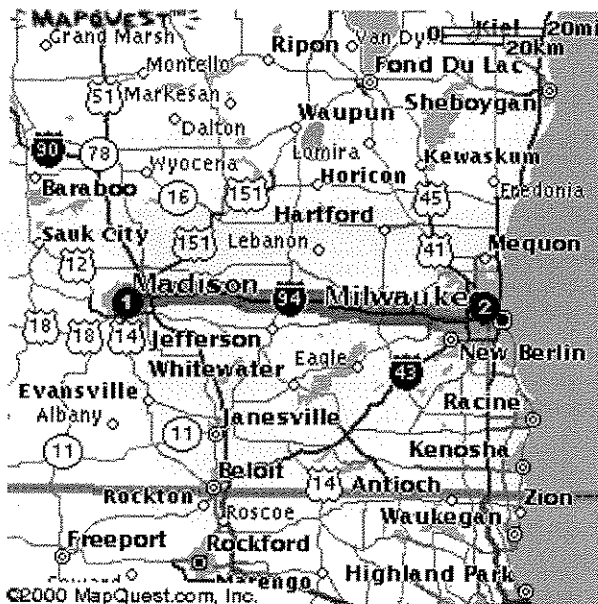

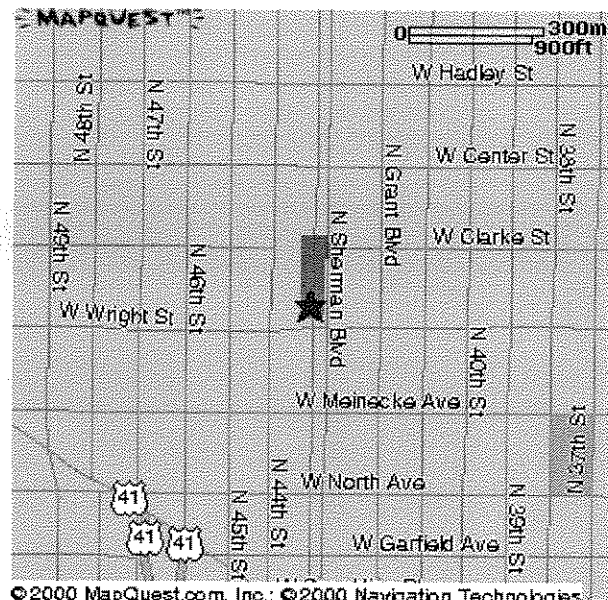

The Legislative Fiscal Bureau prepares a variety of papers to assist the Joint Committee on Finance during its deliberations on the state's budget, other legislation that the Committee addresses and requests under s. 13.10 of the statutes.

Once these papers are prepared, they are placed on the Internet.

The Legislative Fiscal Bureau web page is accessible by: (a) clicking *Legislative Fiscal Bureau* on the Legislature web page (www.legis.state.wi.us); or (b) clicking *Click here to go to the Legislative Fiscal Bureau web page* on the Joint Finance web page (www.legis.state.wi.us/lfb/jfc.html). Links to the Fiscal Bureau papers are located on the Fiscal Bureau web page (www.legis.state.wi.us/lfb) or on the Joint Finance web page (www.legis.state.wi.us/lfb/jfc.html).

2001-03 Budget Papers. Budget papers are available either by clicking on the date of the meeting or by clicking on the cumulative listing.

Papers for {Date}. By clicking on the meeting date, the materials for that meeting will be shown. For each agency or portion thereof, this includes: (a) a cover sheet (which lists papers that have been prepared); (b) budget papers; and (c) a "List of Other Items" (an end sheet that identifies items for which no papers have been prepared). This listing is organized according to the Committee's agenda.

Cumulative Listing of All 2001-03 Budget Papers. The cumulative listing includes all budget papers that have been distributed to date and is arranged in alphabetical order by agency. This

listing will not include the cover sheet or "List of Other Items." The budget papers will remain on the Internet throughout the legislative session.

2001-03 Bill Summaries. The Bureau also prepares summaries of bills scheduled for Joint Finance Committee executive sessions. By clicking on *2001-03 Bill Summaries*, a cumulative listing of bill summaries, to date, will be available. If papers have been prepared for an upcoming meeting, there will be a link at the top of the page for these materials. The cumulative listing of bill summaries is organized by bill number. These papers will remain on the Internet throughout the legislative session.

Section 13.10 Papers. The Committee meets at least quarterly under s. 13.10 of the statutes. By clicking on *Section 13.10 Papers*, a cumulative listing of s. 13.10 papers, to date, will be available. If papers have been prepared for an upcoming meeting, there will be a link at the top of the page for these materials. The cumulative listing of s. 13.10 is organized by meeting date and then by agenda item. They, too, will remain on the Internet throughout the legislative session.
