Thank you for your work on this issue.

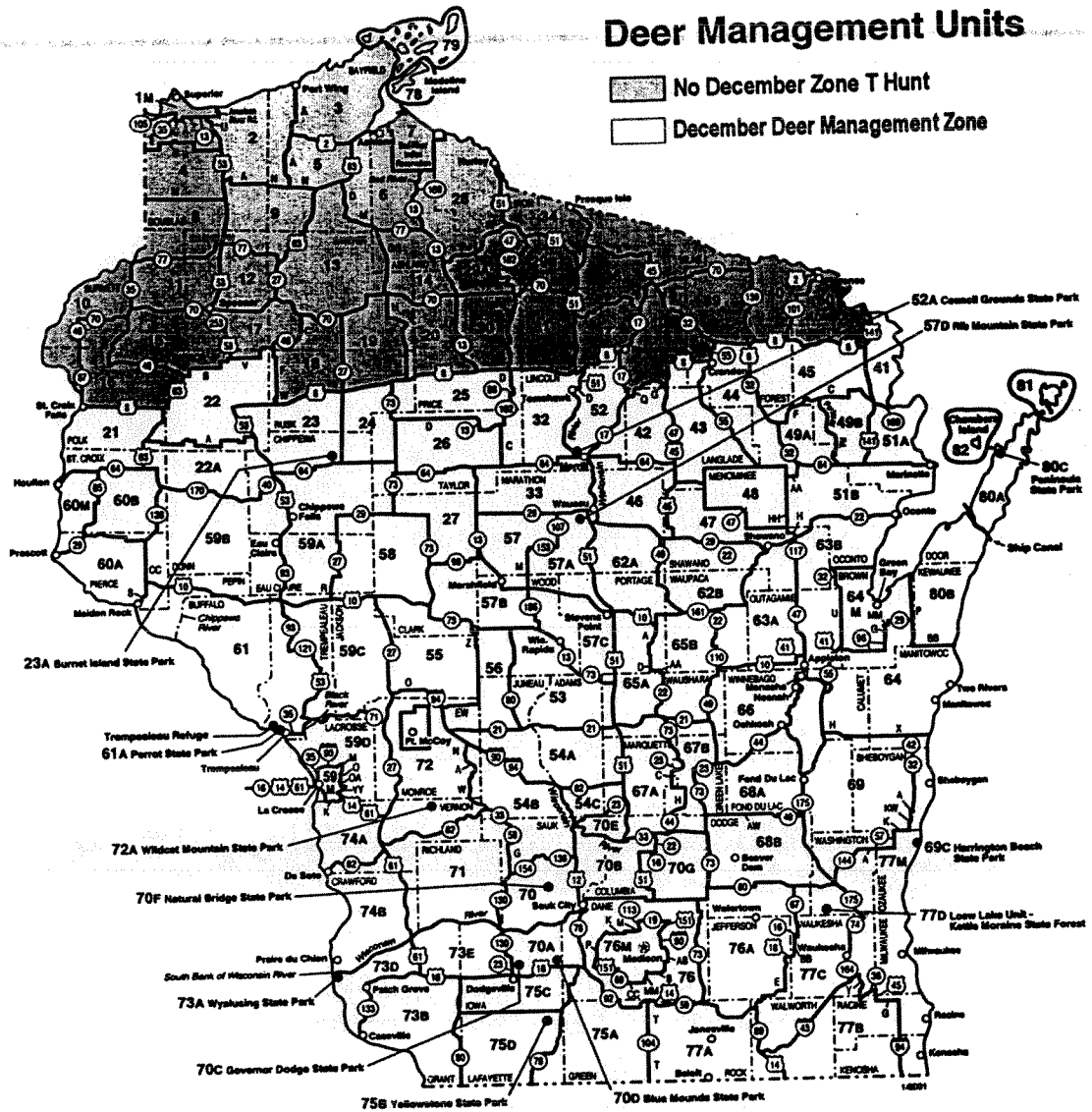

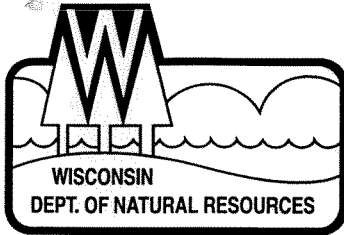

RESOLUTION ON LEGISLATIVE REVIEW OF DEER 2000 RULE ORDER,

WM-40-00, CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 00-154

Whereas, the Deer 2000 process involved over 4 years of public involvement, with all user groups invited to participate, and had over 16,000 people participate with hundreds of the most active donating over 20,000 hours of their time.

Whereas, the Deer 2000 process resulted in a number of significant recommendations, statutory proposals, and rule proposals pertaining to deer management that have been stalled in the State Legislature for almost a year.

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board has approved administrative rule proposals pertaining to deer hunting that were recommended by the Deer 2000 process at their meeting in January 2001, and approved modifications to the rule as a result of Legislative recommendations at their meetings in May of 2001 and October of 2001.

Whereas, the Assembly Natural Resources Committee objected to four components of the Deer 2000 rule proposal at their meeting in November 2001, including the 3 year experimental December hunt and 4 days in November of additional bow hunting in zone T units only.

Whereas, the Joint Committee for Review of Administrative rules is currently reviewing the objections of the Assembly Natural Resource Committee on the Deer 2000 rule order.

Therefore, be it resolved that the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby requests that the Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules take action on the objections to the Deer 2000 rule in December, 2001, rather than delaying action which could result in the suspension of these significant components of the rule for several years through the next State Legislative session.

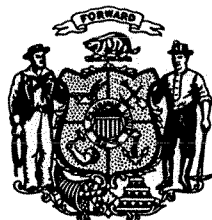

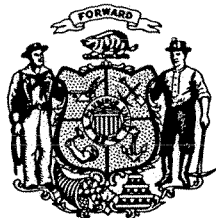

REPORT TO LEGISLATURE

NR 1, 10, 12 and 19, Wis. Adm. Code
Deer hunting and the wildlife damage abatement and claims program

Board Order No. WM-40-00
Clearinghouse Rule No. 00-154

Statement of Need

The proposed rule changes stem from the recommendations of the Deer Management for 2000 and Beyond project. The rule changes establish a new deer season framework for the 2001 season and beyond and establishes a statewide protocol for deer herd control seasons. The proposed order also adds criteria to be considered by the Department when establishing deer population goals for deer management units. The proposed rule also modifies the wildlife damage abatement and claims program.

The proposed season frameworks are meant to optimize hunting opportunities for all hunting interest groups and to control herds that cannot be brought down to goal with a normal hunting season framework. This package will also increase consistency and predictability of season structure while allowing flexibility to deal with years of high and low deer populations. Interested stakeholders could expect the regular framework to be in place each year. When deer populations are low, quotas and permits would control the harvest of antlerless deer. Additionally the probability of needing herd-control seasons will decrease due to expanded regular seasons. The proposed rules:

- Create a permanent 4-day December antlerless deer season

- Add days to the early archery season

- Add days to the late archery season

- Extend the muzzleloader season for 3 days

- Establish a one-day youth gun hunt

- Create a statewide metro unit season framework

- Add a 4-day antlerless only gun season beginning on the Thursday nearest October 22 if the proposed regular season structure outlined above is not expected to bring a deer herd within 20% of the established population load for a deer management unit.

- Add an earn-a-buck requirement to the season structure after 2 years of herd control seasons if the season structure outlined above is not expected to bring a deer herd within 20% of the established population goal for a deer management unit

- Streamline the herd control season decision-making timeline.

- Expand the herd control authority to all deer management units

- Require deer to be registered in the unit or adjoining unit of kill

- Add criteria to be considered by the Department when establishing deer population goals for deer management units

- Establish tolerable levels of agricultural damage

- Modify the current wildlife damage abatement and claims program.

Modifications as a Result of Public Hearings

Agricultural Damage

1) The term "adjusted" was left out of the four criteria that would be used to determine tolerable levels of agricultural damage. The department has added a note explaining that the appraised claim losses exclude, from the measured deer damage yield loss, those losses that involved high valued

specialty crops where a permanent 8 ft. high, woven wire, deer barrier fence would be the program damage management option of choice.

2) Another public comment that precipitated a change to this rule involved the 3-year schedule for unit reviews and the evaluation of tolerable levels of deer damage. If the original proposed language "2 out of the last 3 years since the last review" was used the data needed to evaluate "tolerable levels" would not be available until after the scheduled 3 year review process. To avoid this the proposed language has been modified to read "2 years out of a 3 year period prior to a current unit review".

3) A third concern expressed during the public comment period was whether or not the Department would be able to meet the January 31 deadline for issuance of shooting permits. Since the criteria for automatically issuing these permits is damage losses not paid claims, and these losses are usually measured by late October, counties should be able to provide this information to local Department staff by mid January so that issuance can be made by January 31. However, to avoid any problems the rule was modified so that the Department would be required to issue permits by February 15. The intent is still to have permits out to farmers as early in January as possible, but in the circumstance that the information is delayed from the counties, it will legally give the Department extra time to comply.

4) The rule was also modified so that the issuance of the above permits is automatic rather than administratively intense and expensive.

5) Finally the rule was updated to accommodate "contiguous land" which might straddle, or otherwise cross section boundaries.

Deer season Framework

The rule language prior to the public hearings included two options, earn-a-buck or antlerless only season, of which one was to be included as a stage within the herd control hunts. The public supported the earn-a-buck option. The rule language option of an antlerless only season as part of herd control was eliminated.

Changes at the Natural Resources Board

The Natural Resources Board excluded northern Wisconsin from the 4-day December hunt so that it would not conflict with snowmobiling that may occur during that time.
