
**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Bill Summary: This bill places a ban on any person discharging dredged or fill material into wetlands for which U.S. army corps of engineers (ACE) permits are no longer required as a result of a recent U.S. Supreme Court decision. The provisions of this bill will cease to apply on the day after the effective date of legislation enacted by the Wisconsin Legislature that subjects discharges of dredged or fill material into nonfederal wetlands to a permitting process that conforms to the federal permitting process prior to the date of the referenced U.S. Supreme Court decision.

Fiscal Estimate: This bill has no fiscal impact at either the state or local level. Any monitoring necessary to enforce the provisions of this bill would be already incorporated within the Department's existing workload.

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
