Analysis by the Department of Transportation

This proposed rule amends Trans 276.07(16), and creates Trans 276.07(34m) and (34r), Wisconsin Administrative Code, to add four segments of highway to the designate highway system established under s. 348.07(4), Stats. The actual highway segments that this proposed rule adds to the designated highway system are:

STH 77	USH 53 in Minong	USH 63 in Hayward

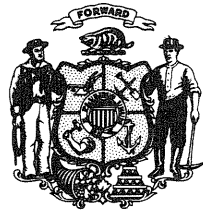
