On December 12, 2001, the committee held a hearing and passed similar legislation (AB 453). AB 769 was introduced in the Assembly by the same bill authors without the non-lemon law provisions. It is the **identical** to Senate Substitute Amendment 1 to AB 453, which was approved unanimously by our committee. (A copy of the bill record for AB 453 is attached)
