Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The absence of any fiscal impact is based upon the following assumptions:

- Operation of an ATV outside the roadway or shoulder of a highway is effectively prohibited, and this prohibition can be consistently enforced to avert damage to landscaping and roadside features.
- All access to subject highways and streets would be at driveways, and would not cross landscaped areas within the highway right-of-way.
- There would be no supplemental signing to emphasize certain highways as preferred ATV routes.

The fiscal estimate does not attempt to estimate prospective user safety and injury or crash costs that may be incurred on local roads or connecting highways if an enabling local ordinance is adopted.
