Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The proposed legislation will not result in an increase in costs for the University of Wisconsin System and its campuses. If school districts are responsible for bussing students from outside the district, there will be an increase in costs to the school districts. The total fiscal impact cannot be determined at this time as it will be related to the number of out-of-district students involved and the amount of bussing required. If the school districts bus these students, they, in turn, will be eligible for state transportation aids.
