## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Under current law, each member of the board of school directors of a first class city school district (currently, only the Milwaukee Public Schools) is paid an annual salary that is determined by the board.

This bill sets the annual salary of the president of the board at \$18,670 and the annual salaries of all other board members at \$18,121. This provision takes effect on the first July 1 occurring after the bill is enacted. The bill also authorizes the board to vote increases to the statutory salaries. Finally, the bill prohibits a board member's salary, during the member's term in office, from exceeding the salary provided when the member took office.
