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Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This fiscal estimate addresses only the impact of the bill on costs related to state employment. The proposal expands the statutory definition of "veteran." This definition determines, among other things, whether applicants for state jobs are eligible for the veterans hiring preference. The proposal would therefore increase the number of individuals eligible for the veterans preference in state hiring. However, this proposal would not have an impact on the state's costs in filling state jobs.
