<b>Subject</b> Certification of mold inspectors and mold remediators		

**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill requires the Department to establish certification requirements for the performance of mold inspection or mold remediation in residential or commercial buildings. The Department is required to develop rules for the program which include certification fees to cover the certifying cost. The bill also requires the Department, beginning January 1, 2005, to certify individuals as mold inspectors or mold remediators if they meet the applicable requirements.

The one-time cost of adding the program to the Department's data base is estimated at \$10,000. It is assumed that the fees which will be set by rule for the certification program will cover the on-going costs of the mold certification program and not result in additional costs to the Department.
