Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under the provisions of ACT 33, the department is required to contract with the Wisconsin Hospital Association for the collection and dissemination of hospital and ambulatory surgery center data. The contract was issued on October 31, 2003. This bill exempts certain ambulatory surgery centers from requirements to supply data under the provisions of Chapter 153. If this bill is enacted, the contract will need to be amended to include this exemption. The effort of amending this contract would be minimal and would be absorbed by the department.
