Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law, with some exceptions, requires a school district to provide transportation to and from school for a pupil attending a private school that is located at least two miles from the pupil's residence. In addition, those school districts that are not required to provide transportation for private school pupils may elect to do so. This bill provides that a school district that must provide transportation for private school pupils may do so only during the school term of the school district and that a school district that elects to provide transportation may provide the transportation at any time.

Local fiscal effect:

It is assumed that individual school districts will reduce their transportation costs if they are required to transport private school pupils only during the district's school term. Only those school districts that transport private school pupils whose school term does not conform to the public school's term would be affected. Because the department is unaware of how many private schools currently conform to public schools' calendars and how many do not, this cost savings is indeterminate.

State fiscal effect:

This bill has no state fiscal effect.
