## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Assembly Bill 803 would create statutes relating to adding one representative from a Veterans Service Organization (VSO) to the Council on Veterans Programs:

The Military Officers Association of America (MOAA)

Under current law the Council on Veterans Programs advises the Board of Veterans Affairs and the Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA) on solutions and policy alternatives relating to the problems of veterans. The council consists of one representative from 24 VSOs, all of whom are appointed for one-year terms.

During FY 03, a total of \$7,169 was spent on travel, meals and lodging expense reimbursement for the Council on Veterans Programs. Of the twenty-four eligible organizations, twenty-two of them sent a representative to the council meetings. The average reimbursement for each council member was \$46 per meeting. It is expected that the Council on Veterans Programs will meet six times in FY 05. Therefore, the estimated annual fiscal effect of adding a new member to the council is \$276 (\$46x6=\$276).
