## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill will allow the Educational Approval Board (EAB) to take possession of student records from certain postsecondary educational institutions that discontinue their operations, propose to discontinue their operations, or are in imminent danger of discontinuing their operations. Under the bill, the EAB would take possession of student records only if they are in danger of being destroyed, secreted, mislaid, or otherwise made unavailable to the persons who are the subjects of those records or the authorized representatives of those persons.

The bill also authorizes the EAB to charge a fee for providing a copy of a student record that is held in its possession and creates an appropriation in which monies collected from student record requests would be deposited. The fee would be based on the administrative cost of taking possession of, preserving, and providing copies of student records, currently estimated to be \$10 per request.

The \$10 fee estimate is based on the following information. It is estimated that the each request for a student record will require 30 minutes to process. This time includes verification of the requestor's identity or their designated representative, the processing of payment, and locating, preparing, and mailing the record. Assuming this work is performed by an entry-level program assistant, the hourly cost is estimated to be about \$15.00 (including salary and benefits).

Due to space limitations, the EAB is not able to maintain all closed school records in its possession at its offices. In general, older records and infrequently requested records are kept at the State Records Center. Current storage costs are \$0.28 per cubic foot per month. In addition to storage costs, when a record that is maintained at the State Records Center is requested, an additional cost of \$2.10 per record is incurred for its retrieval.

Based on the staff time (\$15/hour x 30 minutes = \$7.50/hour), the costs associated with record storage and retrieval, and postage, the EAB estimates that it costs, on average, \$10 to process each student record request.

At the present time, the EAB is the custodian of student records from ten (10) closed Wisconsin schools. In the first seven months of FY 04, the EAB has received approximately 450 requests for copies of student records that are in the EAB's possession. Based on this number, it is assumed that 770 requests will be processed annually. If the EAB charges \$10 a request to provide a student record, the EAB will generate \$7,700 PR annually.
