**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The bill removes the current limit of 6 on the number of deputies appointed by the county coroner. Actual full or part-time positions at the county level are created through the county budget process so the ability to appoint more deputies may not pose additional costs. Some counties use part-time coroners and this would permit them to meet their need without a statutory limit. Some larger counties are also approaching the statutory limit of 6 with full time coroners.

**Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

Unknown as the number of counties that would avail themselves of the option cannot be determined.
