### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill makes changes to current law regarding disciplinary actions involving certain health care professionals, the authority of the Medical Examining Board, malpractice reports required by federal law, and death reports by coroners and medical examiners. The bill requires the Department of Regulation and Licensing to add certain duties related to health care professional regulation and also allows the Medical Examining Board to impose certain penalties on credential holders found guilty of unprofessional conduct. The bill also creates a requirement that certain entities comply with federal regulations regarding health data information and imposes a penalty for failure to do so. Finally, the bill requires coroners or medical examiners to notify the Department of Regulation and Licensing if a death occurs under specified circumstances if the death was a therapeutic-related death.

The Department's Vital Records office provides significant training materials to coroners and medical examiners on their statutory reporting responsibilities. Under this bill, the Department would have to update its training materials and distribute these materials to coroners and medical examiners. It is estimated that the one-time costs of these training materials would be \$2,000. The Department can absorb these costs.
