Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill revises the penalties for certain dog damage/injury violations and permits any person to ask a court to order that a dog be killed. Present law provides that only the state or a municipality may ask for an order to kill a dog.

While the increased forfeiture amounts may increase the revenue collected by the state it is impossible to determine the additional costs that will be incurred by allowing any person to petition the court for an order to kill a dog. Any increase in litigation requires additional judge, court reporter and court staff time. These costs are borne by both the state and the county.
