Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

State Fiscal Effect:

There is no state fiscal effect.

Local Fiscal Effect:

This bill removes the limit on the number of years a school district may enter into a lease with another entity. This flexibility could provide school districts with additional lease revenues. The amount of this potential revenue is indeterminate.
