2003 Wisconsin Act 7 ratifies the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Employees Union, for the 2001-03 Biennium, covering employees in the professional social services collective bargaining unit. The professional social services unit consists of approximately 3,072 full-time equivalent positions and includes chaplains, client services personnel, disability claims personnel, economic support personnel, employment and training personnel, job service personnel, labor market analysts, probation and parole agents, rehabilitation specialists, social workers, unemployment specialists, and others.

Effective Date: The general effective date of Wisconsin Act 7 is May 17, 2003. However, the collective bargaining agreement ratified by Act 7 may contain other specific effective dates covering employees in the professional social services collective bargaining unit.
