2003 Wisconsin Act 19 ratifies the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Attorneys Association, Inc., for the 2001-03 Biennium, covering employees in the professional legal collective bargaining unit. There are approximately 284 full-time equivalent positions in the unit. The unit consists primarily of attorneys employed by the state.

**Effective Date:** The general effective date of Wisconsin Act 19 is May 17, 2003. However, the collective bargaining agreement ratified by Act 19 may contain other specific effective dates covering employees in the professional legal collective bargaining unit.
