2003 Wisconsin Act 319 ratifies the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Employees Union, for the 2003-05 Biennium, covering employees in the professional social services collective bargaining unit. The professional social services unit consists of approximately 3,266 employees and includes chaplains, client services personnel, disability claims personnel, economic support personnel, employment and training personnel, job service personnel, labor market analysts, probation and parole agents, rehabilitation specialists, social workers, unemployment specialists, and others.

Effective Date: The general effective date of Wisconsin Act 319 is May 29, 2004. However, the collective bargaining agreement ratified by Act 319 may contain other specific effective dates covering employees in the professional social services collective bargaining unit.
