

Erin:

1. Bobby doesn't get back until May 21st. She would be available after that in May. In June, she has to be here on June 1st for another meeting and then she will be back for the State FFA Convention the week of June 14th.
2. First of all, while she definitely supports the program, she doesn't believe that farmers can afford any more fee increases! As she read the rule she noticed the contradiction of one part that says there will be no economic effect on farmers but another part said the fees would probably be charged back to farmers, even-though a percentage of monetary effect on farmers is clearly noted. Then, it is clearly stated that there is enough money in the fund to fund the program and the increase is to provide money for future payments, if this is the case, there should be no need for any increase. In addition, she mentioned something about money from the fund being used by DATCP, or someone, for other purposes in the past year and a half and if this is true farmers shouldn't have to pay more to cover a fund raid.
3. As for the pictures, have Jay print them but see me for payment rather than from the office account.
