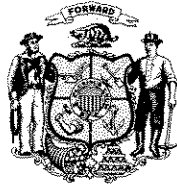

Assembly Bill 841: Relating to various changes to the regulation of hearing instrument specialists, speech-language pathologists, and audiologists and granting rule-making authority.




