





**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The proposed legislation requires that the Board of Regents ensure that, by January 1, 2008, all nursing program credits are to be fully transferable between UW System institutions. Presently four UW System institutions provide full undergraduate programs in nursing (Eau Claire, Oshkosh, Madison and Milwaukee). In addition, the UW System has a collaborative nursing degree completion program developed and made available through the joint efforts of these institutions and Green Bay. This program provides UWS and Wisconsin Technical College System students the opportunity to transfer their credits and complete their nursing degree programs online. The proposed legislation, as presently conceived, will not require any additional expenditure on the part of the university system. Were there to be an additional requirement of automatic transfer of students between nursing programs, additional cost and staff requirements would result. Since, presently, each program is at capacity, any expansion would necessitate additional staff and resources to accommodate additional students and provide required clinical placements.

These are programs that are offered by two or more campuses in the UW system and reflect occupations that are difficult for hospitals to fill. Most of our other difficult to fill positions are either offered exclusively at the technical college level ( Surgical Technologist, Diagnostic Radiographer, Medical Coder), or are only provided by one school in Wisconsin ( Dentistry and Pharmacist). 
