Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau (DOT)

Under current law, certain highway routes and bridges have been designated and marked to memorialize, commemorate, or recognize certain individuals or events. This bill directs the Department of Transportation to designate and, upon receipt of sufficient contributions from interested parties, mark the route of USH 14 in this state from the Wisconsin-Illinois border to Madison as the "Ronald Reagan Highway" in recognition and appreciation of the public career of Ronald Reagan, who served with distinction for two terms as the 40th President of the United States and who subsequently demonstrated grace and dignity in his struggle with Alzheimer's disease. No state funds, other than from contributions from interested parties, may be used for the erection or maintenance of any markers on USH 14 to identify that portion of the highway as the "Ronald Reagan Highway" and the Harriet Tubman Memorial Highway.

This bill directs the Department of Transportation to designate and mark the entire route in this state of STH 122 as the "Harriet Tubman Memorial Highway" in recognition and appreciation of the life of Harriet Tubman, a leader in the movement to abolish slavery in the 19th century who led over 300 slaves to freedom in the North on the Underground Railroad.
