

**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**

Under current law, the State Historical Society is required to serve as the principal historic preservation agency of the state and in that capacity to carry out a program of preservation of historic properties. As part of that program, the State Historical Society is required to conduct an ongoing statewide survey to identify and document historic properties and to provide technical assistance to localities and private parties in furtherance of local and private historic preservation programs.

This bill appropriates \$75,000 in each of fiscal years 2005-06 and 2006-07 for the State Historical Society to award grants to owners of historic agricultural buildings to assist in the restoration of those buildings. The bill requires an owner who receives a grant to match the amount of the grant, use the grant and matching funds to restore the building, and use the restored building for the education, inspiration, pleasure, and enrichment of the citizens of this state. The bill also appropriates \$75,000 in each of those fiscal years for the State Historical Society to enter into a contract for a statewide survey to identify and document historic properties in rural areas of the state.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 44.46 of the statutes is created to read:

**44.46 Historic agricultural building grants. (1)** In this section, "historic agricultural building" means any building or structure that is designed for agricultural purposes and that is significant in the history, architecture, or culture of this state.

**(2)** From the appropriation under s. 20.245 (1) (a), the historical society shall award grants to owners of historic agricultural buildings to assist in the restoration of the buildings. To receive a grant, the owner shall match the amount of the grant, shall agree to use the total amount of funds to restore the historic agricultural building, and shall agree to use the restored historic agricultural building in a manner consistent with the public policy expressed in s. 44.30.

SECTION 2. **Appropriation changes.**

(1) SURVEY OF RURAL HISTORIC BUILDINGS. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the state historical society under section 20.245 (1) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2005, the dollar amount is increased by \$75,000 for fiscal year 2005-06 and the dollar amount is increased by \$75,000 for fiscal year 2006-07 for the purpose of entering into a contract for a survey under section 44.34 (1) of the statutes to identify and document historic properties in rural areas of the state.
