

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires a high school pupil to earn 1.5 credits in physical education in order to be eligible for a high school diploma. This bill authorizes a school board to ~~grant~~ a pupil credit in physical education for ~~participating~~ in an extracurricular sport if the sport is sanctioned by the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association and the pupil earns an additional 1.5 credits in English, social studies, mathematics, science, health education, vocational education, foreign languages, or fine arts. ✓

6 sport if the sport is sanctioned by the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association
7 and the pupil earns an additional 1.5 credits in English, social studies, mathematics,
8 science, health education, vocational education, foreign languages, or fine arts. If a
9 school board adopts a policy under this paragraph, it shall provide the department
10 with a copy.
